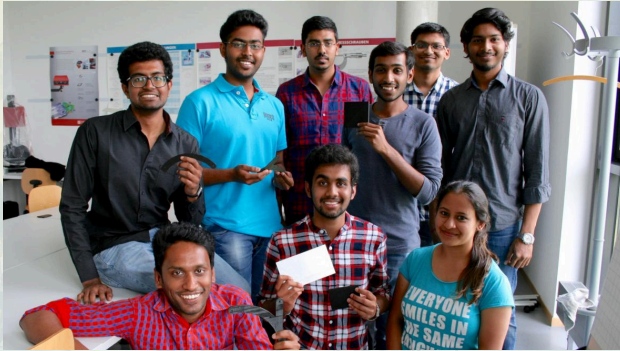

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

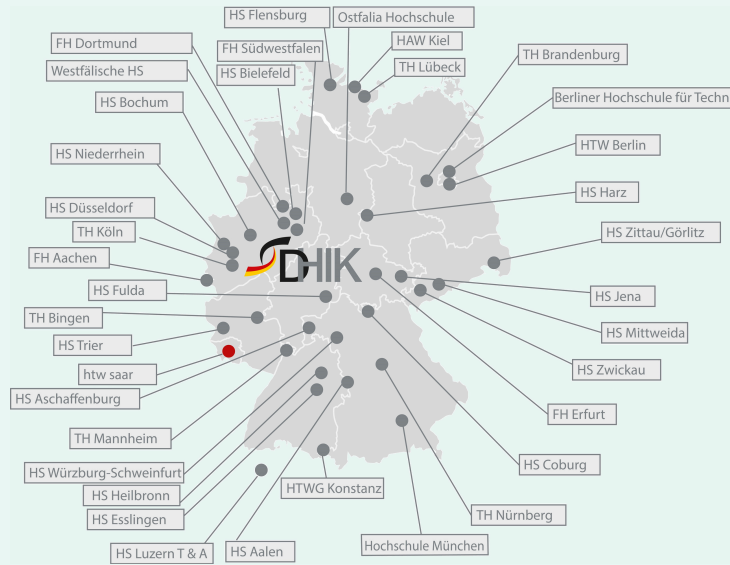

Additional Information:

180 ECTS Credits (European Credit Transfer System). You will need about two semesters to finish your degree and can pursue any four-semester master's programme.
210 ECTS Credits (European Credit Transfer System). You will need about three semesters to finish your degree and can pursue any three- or four-semester master's programme.
Our program offers an optional, fee-based four-week summer school at IHK Düsseldorf after the first year, where students explore German language and culture.
